## Your weekly shopping will cost more

**Much of the food you put on your table comes from EU countries. Think of the vegetables and fruit from Spain; tomatoes from Holland and grapes from Italy.**

Brexit has the potential to have a substantial impact on household food spend. We import around 30% of our food, mostly from the EU. Tariff and exchange rate changes are likely to have a particularly big impact on food prices (Source: *Institute for Fiscal Studies*)

**'The largest greenhouse complex in Europe is in Thanet North. It grows tomatoes 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Those tomatoes are harvested by Poles and Romanians. Why? Despite my requests and the company's endeavours, it cannot recruit British labour to do the job, not because of price but because it is hard work and there are not enough people available to do it.'**
